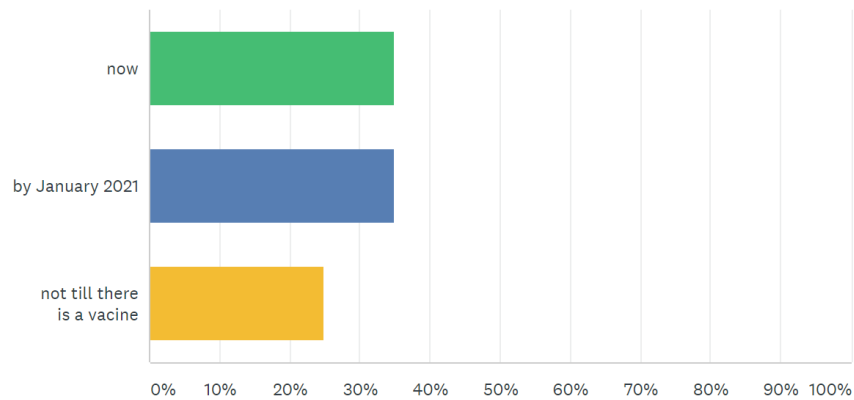

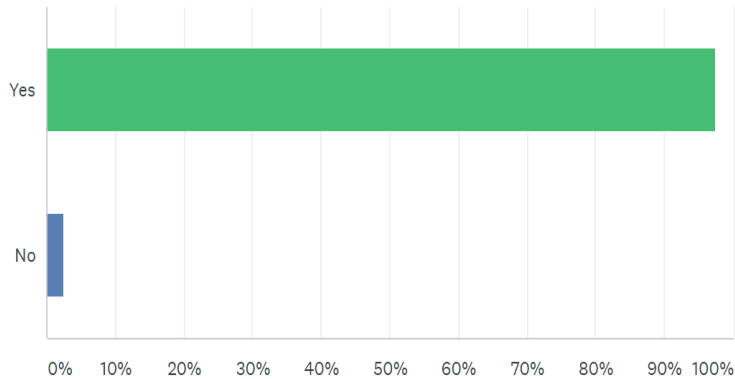

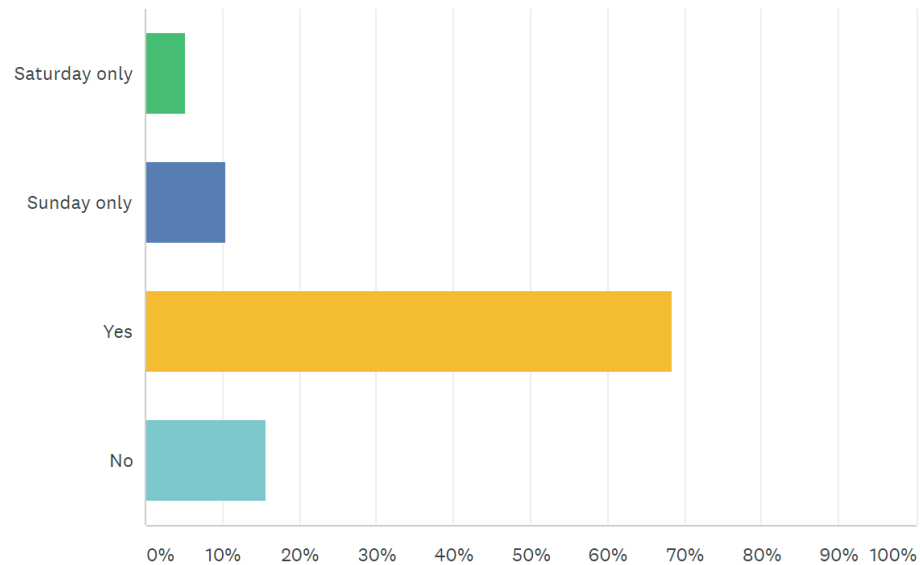

Would you be interested in weekend meetings if we are able to obtain international guest speakers?

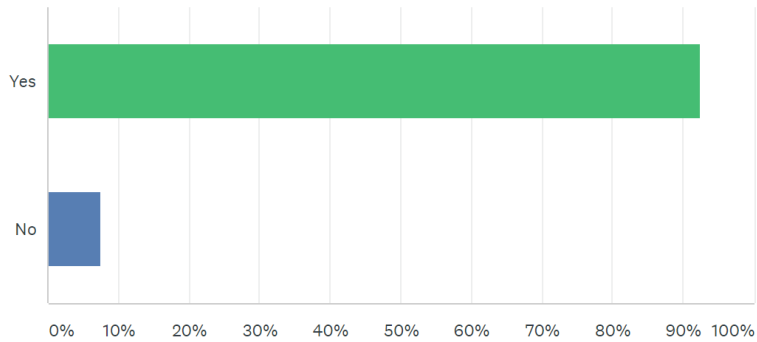

Do you think ZOOM meetings are a good substitute for our monthly programs?

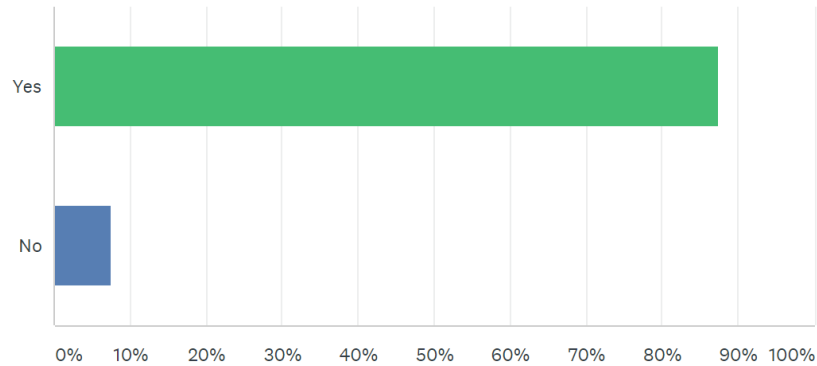

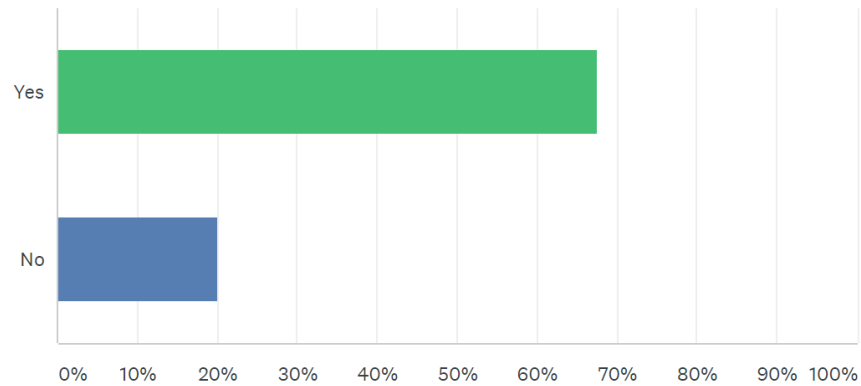

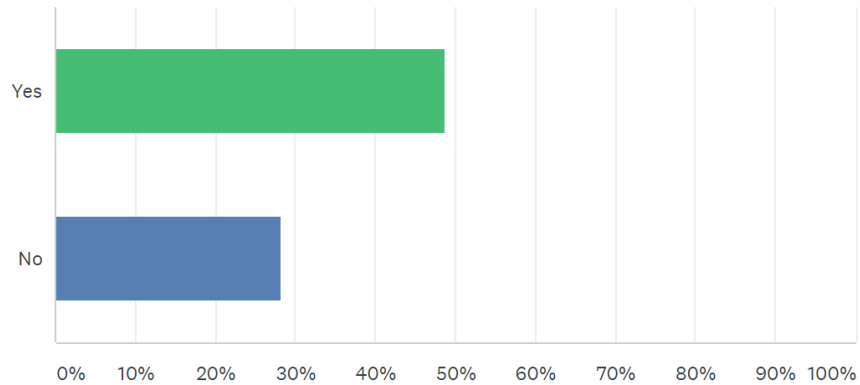

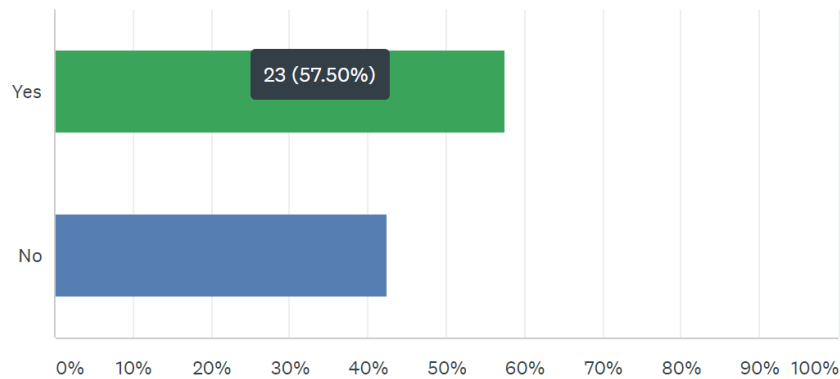

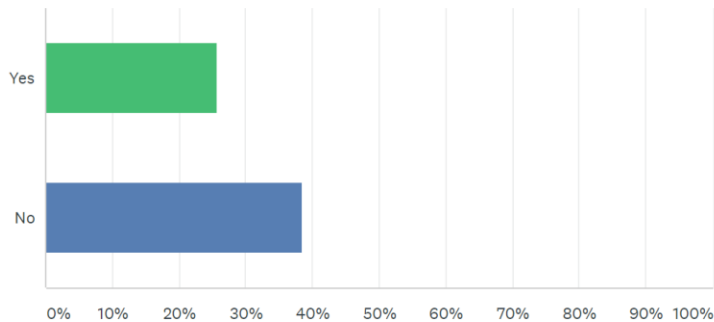
